

## **Manufacturer Safety Recall issued**

- NHTSA #22V155
- Recall #20DN FUEL LEVEL SENDER
- Status: Remedy Available

**Description:** Due to tolerance deviations, the distance between the fuel level sender and a ventilation pipe in the tank may be too small. As a result, the fuel level sender may get stuck on the ventilation pipe which will lead to a drop in the fuel level not being detected and therefore to an incorrect fuel level and remaining range being displayed in the instrument cluster. This may cause the vehicle to run out of fuel even though the indicator shows that there is still fuel in the tank. Inaccurate fuel indication may lead to an engine stall due to fuel starvation, increasing the risk of a crash.

**Remedy:** In order to create a sufficient distance between the fuel level sender and the ventilation pipe, a sensor with tighter geometric tolerances will be installed within the fuel tank.

# **Manufacturer Compliance Recall** issued

**Description:** Due to a hardware issue, the infotainment main unit in the center console may become damaged after the driver turns off the vehicle and the main unit shuts down. Upon the next start, the damaged infotainment unit would not work. In this case, all functionalities including the rearview camera image would not be available. In this case, the vehicle does not comply with regulatory requirements. The vehicle operator will notice upon starting the vehicle that the infotainment screen and the entire main unit is not working and that a rearview image is not displayed when reversing. A rearview camera screen that displays no image reduces the drivers information of what is behind the vehicle, increasing the risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

## **Manufacturer Safety Recall issued**

**Description:** If liquid reaches and enters the gateway control module located under the rear middle seat, usually due to a liquid spill on the rear seats, it is being switched off as part of the safety concept. Water/liquid ingress into the gateway control module may lead to various internal errors due to short circuits within the control unit. ..The gateway control module has a safety concept in case implausible signals are detected in the control unit. If such implausible signals are detected, the gateway switches off its function in order to avoid unwanted vehicle reactions. The vehicle remains steerable and the brake system is fully operable. The engine goes into emergency mode and remains in operation with reduced power. Unexpected reduced engine power may create an increased risk of a crash in certain driving situations.

**Remedy:** Install a protective cover for the gateway control module which will protect the part from liquid ingress.

#### First Owner

When the first owner(s) obtains a title from a Department of Motor Vehicles as proof of ownership.

#### **Manufacturer Recall**

Automobile manufacturers issue recall notices to inform vehicle owners of a safety defect or failure to meet minimum federal safety or emissions standards. Manufacturer recalls are repaired at no cost to the customer.

#### **Ownership History**

CARFAX defines an owner as an individual or business that possesses and uses a vehicle. Not all title transactions represent changes in ownership. To provide estimated number of owners, CARFAX proprietary technology analyzes all the events in a vehicle history. Estimated ownership is available for vehicles manufactured after 1991 and titled solely in the US including Puerto Rico. Dealers sometimes opt to take ownership of a vehicle and are required to in the following states: Maine, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania and South Dakota. Please consider this as you review a vehicle's estimated ownership history.

A state issues a title to provide a vehicle owner with proof of ownership. Each title has a unique number. Each title or registration record on a CARFAX report does not necessarily indicate a change in ownership. In Canada, a registration and bill of sale are used as proof of ownership.
